1	The Assessor has sufficient knowledge and understanding of good practice to be able to work on assessment tasks without placing an excessive burden on other consultants which might compromise safety or quality. Level One Assessors may not have had previous experience of working on rail industry projects. It may therefore be necessary to extrapolate from evidence of technical skills derived
2	The Assessor has sufficient knowledge and understanding of good practice and has sufficiently demonstrable experience, to be able to work on the tasks associated with the overall activity without the need for detailed supervision. A Level Two Assessor will maintain their knowledge and be aware of the current developments in the context in which they work. . A Level Two Assessor may be required to perform detailed checks on the work carried out by a Level One
3	The Assessor has sufficient understanding of why things are done in certain ways, and sufficiently demonstrable skills, to be able to undertake overall responsibility for leading a task or project. A Level Three Assessor will be familiar with the ways in which systems or products have failed in the past. They will keep abreast of technologies, architectures, application solutions, standards, and regulatory requirements. They will have sufficient breadth of experience, knowledge and understanding to be able to work in novel situations. They are able to deal with a multiplicity of problems under pressure without jeopardising safety or quality
